



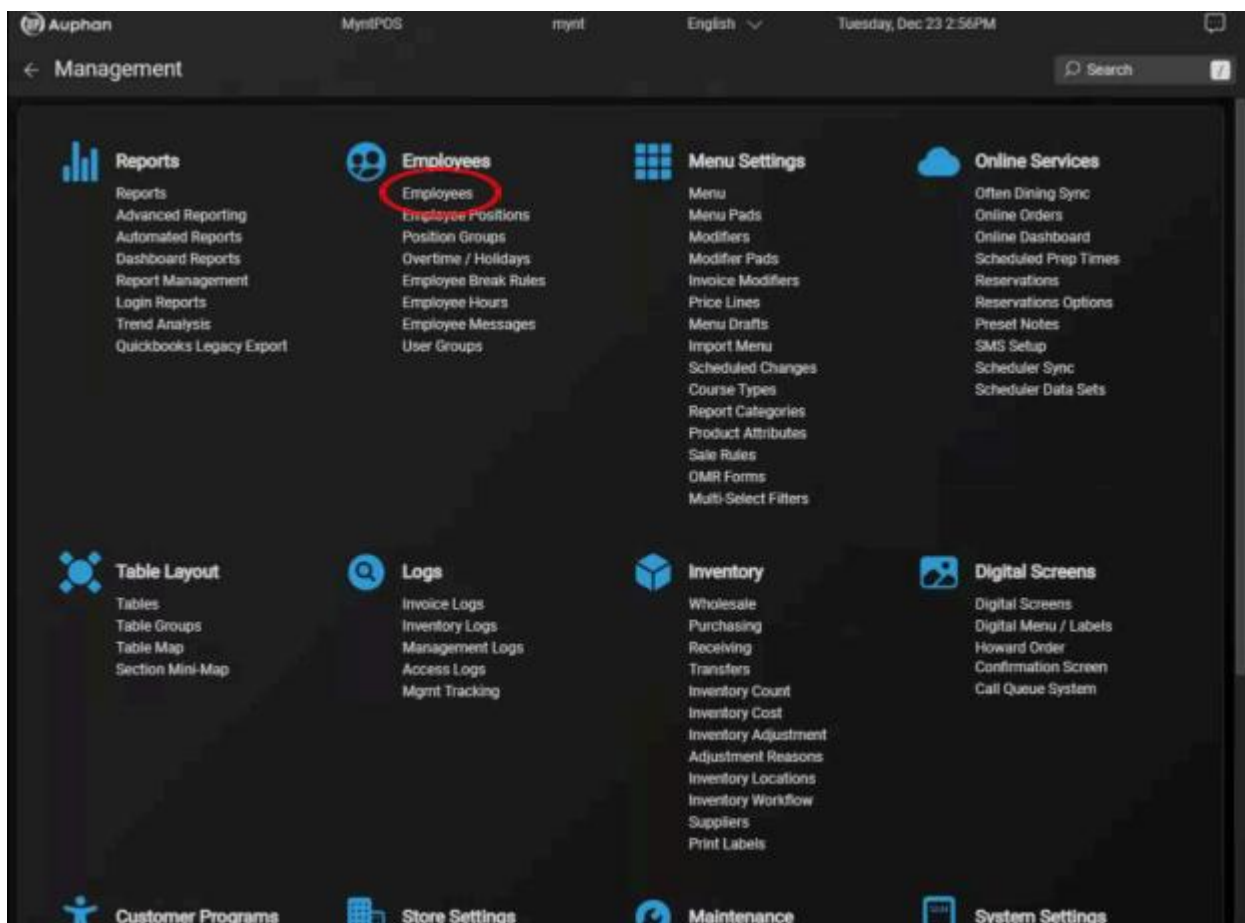
HOW TO SET UP AND USE REMOTE ACCESS

MYNT CORE & ENTERPRISE

This is a step-by-step guide on how to configure and use both methods of remote access in Mynt.

- 1) Username and Password
- 2) Auphan ID

Method 1 - Username and Password



Open "Employees" under the "Employees" section in Management.

Open the Employee you wish to grant Remote Access to by pressing "Edit".

Scroll to the bottom right, under the “Secure Login” field. Ensure “Remote login” is checked. Set “Login Type” to “Password”, then enter a Username and Password, following the requirements below.

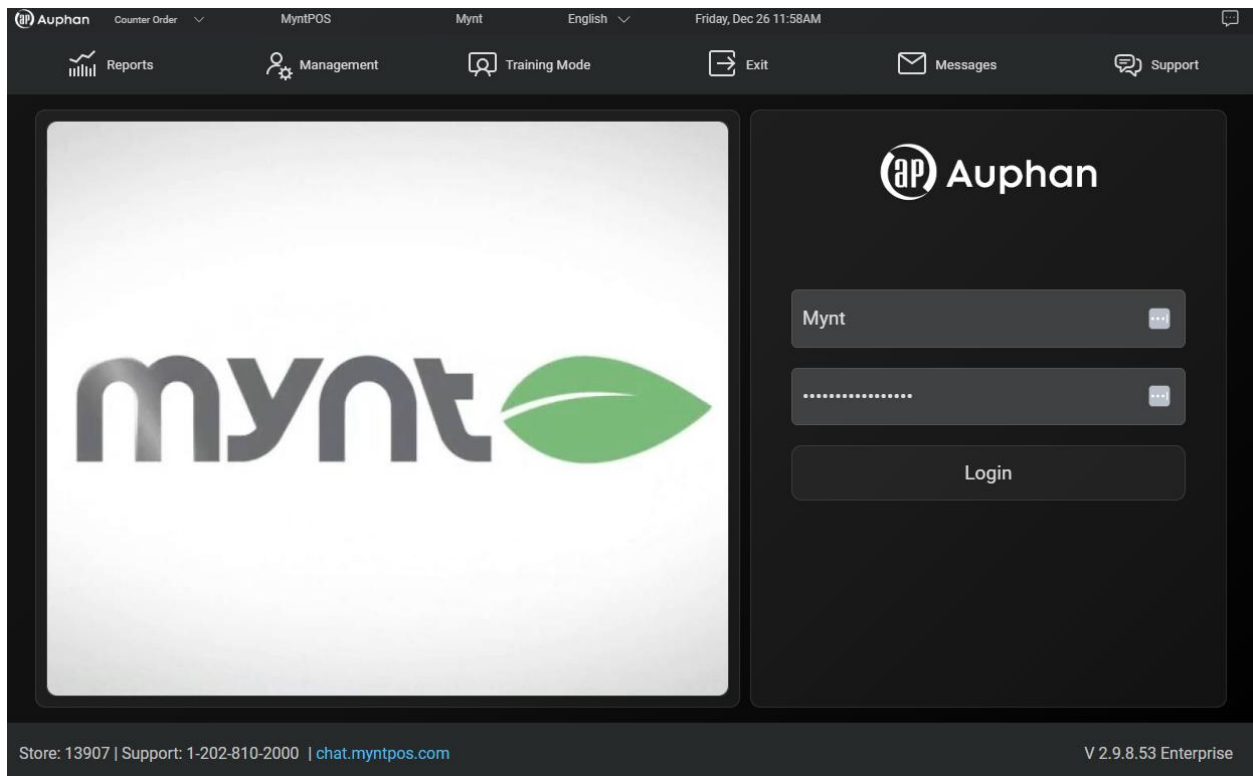

After using the login button, a window will open with the normal Mynt screen you are used to. The username and password will automatically be filled out, and you can just use the remote system as you wish! Please Note that if you login and add tickets, or make any changes, it will add them in real time to the POS.

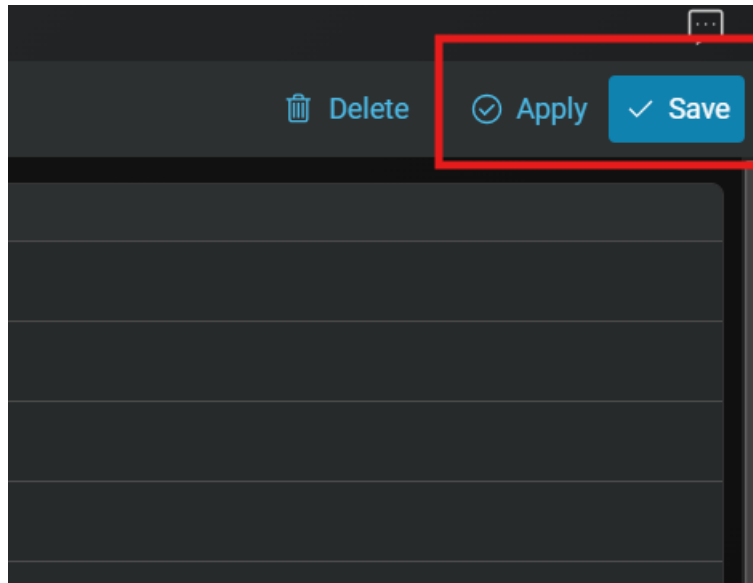


Method 2 – Auphan ID

The advantage of Auphan ID is the ability to tie multiple locations to one account, rather than having to track multiple different logins. This is especially useful for agents.
